Arena size: 20m × 60m | All trot rising or sitting | Video from C for judging

Purpose: To confirm the horse demonstrates correct basics and, building on Preliminary level, shows lengthened strides, leg yields and counter canter while remaining reliably on the bit with balance and self-carriage. Trot may be rising or sitting.

3	A	On centre line	Straightness on centre line; horse remains parallel, forward and regular in the leg yield; consistent flexion
	LM	Leg yield right	
4	HP	Change rein, show some lengthened strides	Clear lengthening of frame and stride while keeping rhythm and balance; straightness; clear transitions
	P	Working trot	
5	A	On centre line	Straightness on centre line; horse remains parallel, forward and regular in the leg yield; consistent flexion
	LH	Leg yield left	
6	C	Medium walk	Willing, clear transition; regularity and quality of walk
	MS	Change rein in medium walk	
7	SP	Change rein, free walk on long rein	Reach and ground cover of free walk allowing complete freedom to stretch the neck forward and downward; straightness; clear, balanced transitions
	P	Medium walk	
8	F	Working trot	Willing, calm transitions; correct lead; quality of trot and canter
	A	Working canter right	
9	V	Circle right 15m diameter	Quality of canter; shape and size of circle; bend; balance
10	VS	Working canter	Quality of canter; balance in the turn; willing, calm transition to trot; accuracy of line
